## CONDITIONS FOR USE OF THE BUILDINGS & SITE

### Buildings

Take care in removing and replacing the shutters; avoid bending the bolts.

No smoking in any of the buildings. If you must smoke on site please dispose of your cigarette ends properly. Do not throw them down on the ground or in the wood.

**Never** have gas heaters alight in any room when it is being used for sleeping, and make sure that clothing is not placed on top of, or too close to the heaters.

If outside doors are left open, fix them with the hooked stays provided. No ball or rough games are allowed indoors .

Furniture must not be moved from the buildings or used outside in damp conditions. Wear soft shoes indoors whenever possible.

It is permitted to use radios etc on site in moderation. Other site users and our neighbours must be considered at all times. Observe complete quiet between 10.30 pm and 6.30 am.

Do not put drawing pins in the walls or woodwork; use the notice boards. Do not use Blue-tack on the notices boards or walls because it damages the surface.

Sleeping is allowed in the buildings only with adult supervision. The bunk rooms are available for use by adults only. Please leave them clean and tidy.

Any accidents, damage or breakages must be reported to the Warden.

Report fire extinguishers emptied for any reason to the Warden **immediately** and tie a note to the empty cylinder.

All rubbish should be placed in the bin near the main gate.

Red V mops have been provided in both buildings for use in sweeping the main halls. They **must not** be used on wet or muddy floors.

### Site

No fireworks are allowed on site at any time

Vehicles must be parked on the main car park - nowhere else on site.

Cleanliness of the site and buildings is the responsibility of the users.

Keep to established paths; do not make new ones through the wood.

Camping is not allowed on the central part of 'The Glade'.

Light fires only on fireplaces, **not** on grassed areas. Use timber/logs from the wood piles, please do not take more than you need and use appropriate size on fires - do not cut/split on grassed areas and clear up chips before leaving, clean up your fireplace and restack surplus wood on wood piles. If you use the larger logs for seats, please return to where you got them and do not leave on the grass, as it makes mowing difficult.

If you wish to use a camp oven, please check with the warden first. No wet pits to be dug. Perforated buckets are available from the warden staff if required.

The trenching of camp sites is discouraged. We have difficulty in getting the grass to grow on the site and if it is dug up in bad weather this makes the problem worse. Please think ahead when planning your site.

Cold ashes and rubbish that cannot be burned to be placed in the bin provided near the main gate.

It is the responsibility of those using the Camp Fire Circle to clean up the fireplace afterwards.

It is permitted to use radios etc on site in moderation. Other site users and our neighbours must be considered at all times. Observe complete quiet between 10.30 pm and 6.30 am.

Any accidents, damage or breakages must be reported to the Warden.

No live trees or bushes are to be cut without the Warden's express permission. Leave trees, flowers and plants for others also to enjoy .

Dogs are allowed on site provided they are kept on a lead at all times and exercised off the camping and activity areas. Any fouling must be cleaned up and disposed of properly.

Site trolleys are available for the use of all campers free of charge. The key to these is available from the Warden.

### Toilet Block

Avoid waste of water; it is paid for by meter. Draw water for use on sites from the tap at the water tower or outside of both Buildings.

Washing up is not allowed in or near the Toilet Block. You are responsible for cleaning the Toilet Block.

### Pioneering

Protect trees from chaffing by wrapping sacking round them, and fill in all holes made during pioneering exercises with soil and replace the turf.
